

# THE MANOR CAFE TANK-BAG ROUTE CARD

## Route One - Wensleydale Circuit via Devils Bridge

In association with



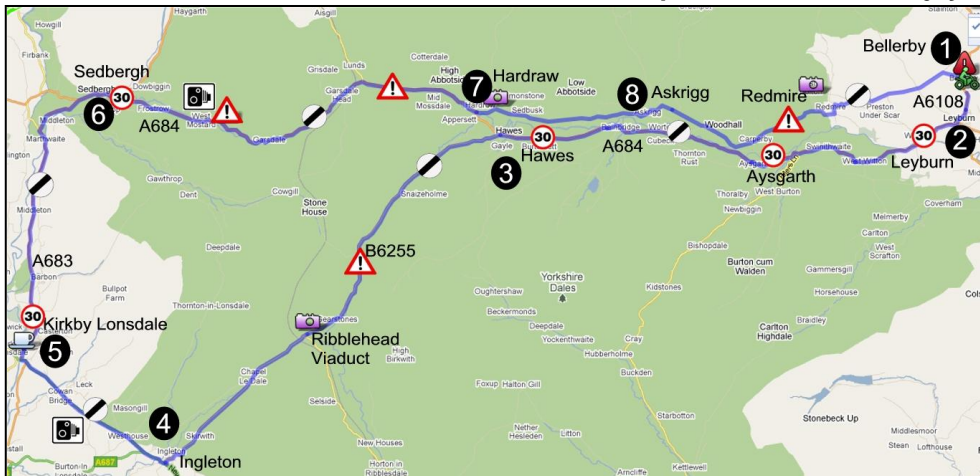
A good mix of long straights with technical bends and stunning scenery as you ride through Chapel Le Dale towards Ingleton and then on the return loop to Hawes and Leyburn.

134 km (approx 2 hours ride time)

Good staggered stop-off points for refreshments and fuel.

Highlights: Mainly long open moor roads with good sweeping turn open views. Some enclosed wall narrow road sections on the return loop.

Most road surface is average to good with few potholes. Always be on the lookout for Farm access routes and livestock on open moor roads....Enjoy!

1. Turn **RIGHT** out of the Cafe on the **A6108**
2. Straight through **LEYBURN** on the **A684** to **HAWES** via *Wensley, West Witton, Aysgarth & Bainbridge.*
3. At the top of **HAWES** just past the Garage, turn **LEFT** on the **B6255** to **INGLETON** via *Ribblehead Viaduct & Chapel Le Dale.*
4. Through **INGLETON** turn **RIGHT** onto the **A65** to **KIRKBY LONSDALE.**
5. Turn **RIGHT** onto the A683 at **DEVILS BRIDGE** and continue **SEDBERGH.**
6. In **SEDBERGH**, turn **LEFT** onto the **A684** towards Kirkby Stephen. After ½ mile, turn **RIGHT** onto the **A684** to **HAWES.**
7. Just before **HAWES**, turn **LEFT** to **HARDRAW**, continue through to **ASKRIGG.**
8. Through **ASKRIGG**, turn **RIGHT** onto the **LEYBURN** road through **REDMIRE.**
9. Turn **RIGHT** on **MOOR ROAD** or **LEYBURN** road into **BELLERBY** and back to The Manor Cafe.
