Route Three - Tan Hill Inn & Arkengarthdale

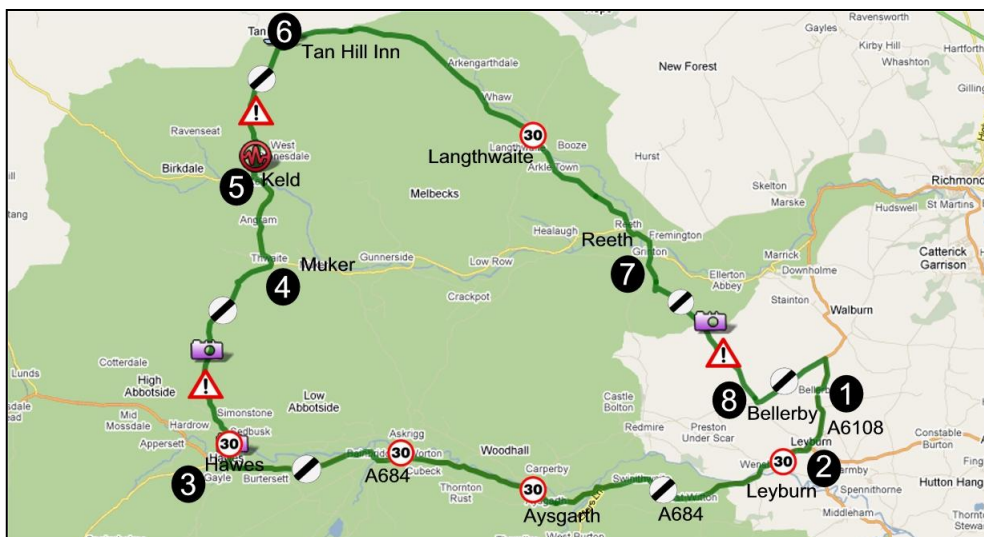


Take a ride-out to the highest Inn in Gt.Britain at 1732ft above Sea Level. It's a remote as you can get, the roads are narrow and winding but boy they're fun! Take the loop down Arkengarthdale in Reeth and across Redmire Tops back to The Manor.

100km (approx 1 hr 45 min ride time)

Highlights: Buttertubs Pass, Tan Hill Inn, open moor roads with good new surfaces in many places.

1. Turn **RIGHT** out of the Cafe on the **A6108**
2. Straight through **LEYBURN** on the **A684** to **HAWES** via *Wensley, West Witton, Aysgarth & Bainbridge.*
3. Just as you enter **HAWES** turn **RIGHT** at the Rope Makers towards **MUKER** via Simonstone. After a mile, turn **LEFT** then next **RIGHT** over **BUTTERTUBS PASS.**
4. Turn **LEFT** onto the **B6270** to **KELD**
5. ½ mile past the Keld Lodge turn **RIGHT** towards **TAN HILL** via *West Stonesdale*
6. Turn **RIGHT** to Tan Hill Inn and then all the way down Arkengarthdale to **REETH** via *Langhwaite.*
7. At the Bridge Inn over the River Swale, turn **RIGHT** (straight on) towards **LEYBURN** past the Military Ranges.
8. Turn **LEFT** towards **CATTERICK / RICHMOND**, then **RIGHT** towards **BELLERBY / LEYBURN** and back to The Manor Cafe.
