Route Two - Buttertubs Pass & Swaledale Circuit

Take a ride over what has been described as 'the most beautiful Mountain Pass in Great Britain' regularly used on Top Gear for test drives and a stunning entrance to the run down Swaledale.

67km - (approx 1 hour 15 mins ride time)

Highlights: More of a technical run than an open throttle ride. You'll not want to rush this one as there are endless photographic opportunities.

The Buttertubs section is open moor so do look out for Sheep and oncoming cars in the middle of the road. Welcome to Swaledale.

1. Turn **RIGHT** out of the Cafe on the **A6108**
2. Straight through **LEYBURN** on the **A684** to **BAINBRIDGE** via *Wensley, West Witton & Aysgarth*.
3. Through **BAINBRIDGE** veer **RIGHT** past the Rose & Crown towards **ASKRIGG** after ½ mile turn **LEFT** towards **HARDRAW / LEYBURN**.
4. 200yds after the Leyburn turn - Turn **RIGHT** to **MUKER** via Simonstone and the **BUTTERTUBS PASS**.
5. Turn **RIGHT** onto the **B6270** to **REETH** via *Muker, Gunnerside, Low Row & Healaugh*.
6. Stay on the **B6270** towards Richmond through Fremington & Grinton and past Ellerton Abbey on your left.
7. Turn **RIGHT** towards **CATTERICK / LEYBURN** & merge into the **A6108** towards **LEYBURN**.
8. Turn **RIGHT** to **LEYBURN**, then **LEFT** into **BELLERBY** and back to The Manor Cafe.
